If so, how will the contract price be determined for this Time and Material project?</p>	<p><b>No. Due to the contract being IDIQ - Time and Material you are not required to carry the Performance or Payment bonds.</b></p>
<p>2 Can the pricing document contained in “B.2 Contract Ceiling Price – Time and Material Price Schedule” be modified and/or submitted in excel format?</p>	<p><b>Yes. The Pricing Schedule Breakdown can be submitted in Excel Format.</b></p>
<p>3 For past performance requirements in section L.1 – volume 1 – (b) Technical Qualification – i. Past Performance (page 137 of TAB B1 Template), “10 to 15 Discrete Scopes of Work with Contract Values ranging from \$15K to \$150K.” are requested to be provided. Is the offeror allowed to use its subcontractors past performance as its own to meet the technical factors evaluation? Similarly, if the offeror is an SBA-approved small business joint venture (JV), can it use its JV members past performance also?</p>	<p><b>Yes. The offeror may use the past performance of its subcontractors to meet the technical evaluation factors, provided that the subcontractor will be involved with the portions of work associated with that experience. If the offeror intends to use a subcontractor for asbestos abatement, the proposal should include the relevant past performance of that subcontractor as well.</b></p> <p><b>If the offeror is an SBA approved small business joint venture, the JV may also rely on the relevant past performance of its JV members. In all cases, the proposal must clearly demonstrate that the offeror’s team—whether through the prime, subcontractors, or JV members—collectively possesses the experience necessary to perform the required work.</b></p>
